### English Translation

Karlsruhe, September 24, 1928

Dr. Mark

Dear Professor,

Today, I haven't reached a decision to travel to Ludwigshafen because I don't think I've sufficiently prepared myself for the necessary tasks in Berlin. I don't wish to come until the end of this week or early next week. I have indexed and compiled a number of possible space groups for the diagrams on  $\text{MgZn}_2$  that Dr. Wolf gave me, which I will discuss with Dr. Möller here tomorrow. In addition, I took a few X-rays here and indexed them. Unfortunately, during Dr. Möller's six-day absence, I was completely dependent on myself, and I have not made very much progress during this time.
